

## Capital Gain Distributions: 2022 Estimates

The anticipated long-term and short-term capital gain distributions for 2022 are listed below. The actual distribution amounts will be based on gains and losses realized through February 28. Estimates on a per-share basis will be available by December. The Fund's long -term approach to investing means that the capital gains realized in a particular year can be the result of an investment held over an extended period of time. The amount of capital gain distributions may vary year over year since the distributions are based on net capital gains realized each year.
